She produces very typey foals with excellent dispositions. She is open for 2011, but will breed to ranch stallion of your choice.

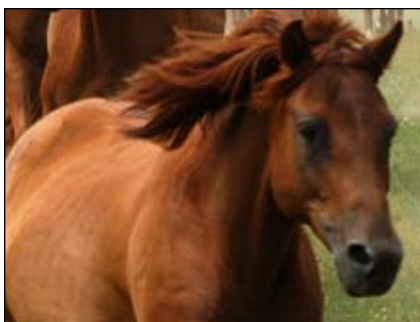

- A daughter of Saturday Nite Line, ROM sire, World Show qualifying sire, European Champion sire AQHA Western Riding (Zan Parr Bar X Paclamar Sweetie x Parkers Trouble) X Strawberry Star Eyed x Strawberry Jack x Two Eyed Jack. A really balanced mare with a lot of type. Very correct on her legs, long hip and nice carry-down muscling. She is an exceptionally easy keeper. What she needs is daily handling and attention. In our large herd she does not receive this. She can be bred to Sunup stallion of your choice.

This mare requires some reproductive work. She is easy to handle, easy keeper and comes from our best mare family. She is young and is in prime condition.



Poquito Charm

Poquito Charm - 2004 chestnut mare
A granddaughter of Skipper's King out of one of our best families going to George Paul (Bert x N.R. Jacci) and E.Z. Dawson x Wimpy II. This is Sunup Ranch's foundation. To top it off her sire was the last breeding son of the famed Skipper's King x Skippper W. You will find generations of this mare's family in our herd. This mare is wonderfully made beautiful head, neck, hip. Nice muscling.

We kept her as a replacement filly, but we have had trouble getting her to settle. She has regular heat periods, has been live covered, but has not conceived. We have not done an extensive amount of work to get her in foal such as ultrasounds, etc. She was first bred as a 5 year old. She is a 7 year old now. To the right buyer, we would work with them to get her bred. We have full sisters and 3/4 sisters to this mare and they are among our top producers.

The following group of mares need special homes. They may make good mares to collect stallions with, or they would make good pasture mates. With one mare, someone with interest in trying for an embryo from a great granddaughter of Rey Del Rancho, may want to take a chance. These mares are offered to good homes, no strings attached.

Her sire, Rancho Sunup was by our son of Rey Del Rancho, Tee Bar Hitone (ROM working cow horse), King Ranch branded. Her dam was a daughter of George Paul. She is a healthy mare, stays in good condition and shows regular heat. She, however, has not settled in the last 2 years. For someone willing to try for an embryo from close-up foundation bloodlines that are hard to find, she might be the mare. She receives no extra care, her feet are perfect, she is sound, but she is sway backed. Here's an opportunity for the person who really wants to get close to these foundation horses and who would be willing to take a try.
